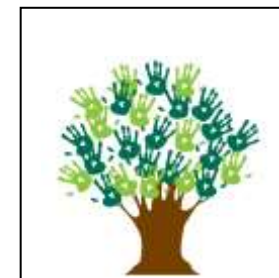

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Will I receive a written report to take home?**
Yes: You will receive a written report in the Summer Term each year which will include information you have seen before in your TLCs
- **Do I need to attend TLCs?**
Yes please. Our experience and feedback shows that the more parents/carers are involved in and understand how well their children are doing, the better they do!
- **What if I miss a TLC?**
In cases of emergency, every effort will be made by the school to re-arrange it, subject to good use of teacher time.
- **What if I want to speak to the teacher on my own?**
Additional appointments may be made if you have something private to share with the teacher, otherwise it is hoped that everything can be shared with your child.
- **My child has special needs, will this be different for him/her?**
It shouldn't be. TLCs comply with SEN regulations and progress will be reviewed and discussed with you at this time. However, you may need an additional appointment so that other professionals may attend.

What will be different?

Termly Learning Conferences enable you to receive lots of information about your child's progress in learning and the strategies and interventions we are using in school and what you can do to help to support them.

Over the year, your child and the class teacher will "build" the written report using information you have discussed at each TLC.

Teachers will ensure that relevant comments are updated in the report / summary throughout the year.

What do I have to do?

You will be invited by your children to attend each TLC with them.

You will be asked to give comments at the end of your TLC time to see how the process is working as well as commenting on your child's progress. The Headteacher and Governors will also conduct questionnaires after the summer TLCs which you may be asked to participate in. This helps us to evaluate the process and improve it where necessary.
