

Key Stage 2 SATs confirmed data September 2023

Children in Year 6 were awarded a scaled score in Reading and Maths. 100+ represented the “expected” standard and if a child attained 110+ this represented a high level of attainment (greater depth). The children did not sit a writing test; the scores represent a teacher assessment.

The table below shows how many children attained expected+ or greater depth compared to the national average.

Average Scaled Scores

The table below shows what our average scaled score was in Reading and Maths, compared to the national average scaled score in both of these subjects.
